Deadline Approaching: Have Your Say on Hamilton's Policing Strategic Plan

The Hamilton Police Service Board (Board) is reminding residents that the deadline to complete the confidential community survey on the Board's Strategic Plan is **11:59 p.m. on Thursday, July 31, 2026**.

The survey, which opened to the public on June 1, 2026, is a key part of the Board's efforts, in consultation with the Chief of Police, to develop an updated Strategic Plan that will shape the future of policing in Hamilton. The plan will define priorities, guide resource allocation, improve services and strengthen relationships between the Board, the Hamilton Police Service, community partners and the public.

"This is truly a community-driven process," the Chair of the Board noted. "Community survey input will help inform recommendations for future planning and service improvements."

Residents who have not yet completed the survey are encouraged to do so before the deadline. Responses will help build a clear, measurable, community-driven roadmap for policing in Hamilton.
